

Implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development in Viet Nam

Context

In September 2015, the United Nations General Assembly adopted the Agenda 2030 for Sustainable Development and the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The 2030 Agenda contains a set of 17 goals to end poverty, protect the planet, and ensure prosperity for all as part of a new sustainable development agenda. Each goal has specific targets to be achieved up to 2030. In Viet Nam, the Ministry of Planning and Investment (MPI) is responsible for the coordination of the implementation, monitoring and reporting of the 2030 Agenda. The MPI has coordinated consultation workshops with various stakeholders to draft the National Action Plan to implement the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development (NAP) which was adopted by the Prime Minister on 10 May 2017.

The SDGs entail a more complete and ambitious set of targets and indicators than their predecessors, the Millennium Development Goals. The monitoring of all 17 Viet Nam SDGs with 115 targets covering all three dimensions of sustainability – social, economic and environmental – is a challenging task.

In the framework of the Initiative Programme “Initiating the implementation of the 2030 Agenda” of the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development, GIZ supports the Government of Viet Nam in strengthening their capacities in monitoring and reporting of the 2030 Agenda.



Our objective

The overall objective is to strengthen the capacity of the Government of Viet Nam in monitoring and reporting of the implementation of the Agenda 2030.



Our Approach

The project supports its main partner, the MPI, in three main areas:

1. Improving the institutional arrangements for the implementation
 - We support different line ministries and provinces in drafting their action plans to implement the 2030 Agenda
 - We work with the General Statistics Office on the indicators to monitor the progress towards the SDGs
 - We assist the Government of Viet Nam in developing guidelines to integrate the Vietnam SDGs-indicators into the national statistical indicator system
 - We develop an on-line platform to visualize the progress on the implementation
 - We support the MPI in developing guidelines for reporting mechanism on Vietnam SDGs.

2. Capacity development

- We conduct capacity building in statistics, innovative methods of data collection, monitoring tools and reporting
- We organize awareness-raising in order to disseminate knowledge of the 2030 Agenda in Viet Nam.

3. Regional and international knowledge exchange

- We support the preparation of the Voluntary National Annual Report 2018 as well as the Vietnamese delegation to the High Level Political Forum in New York
- We assist the Government of Viet Nam in joining regional and international peer-learning networks and initiatives related to lessons learnt in the process of 2030 Agenda implementation.
